



Sustainable Development Week 2010

SERVAIR receives Roissy Charles de Gaulle Airport's "Eco-Friendly Actions" Trophy, awarded by ADP and the ADEME.

Base Handling, a subsidiary of Servair, receives this Trophy for its exemplary and innovative measure to recover water from ice-cubes.

Roissy, 8th April 2010 – SERVAIR, the largest company in France and the 3rd largest worldwide to provide aircraft catering services and air transport logistics, has just been awarded the "Eco-Friendly Actions" Trophy by ADP (Paris Airports) and the ADEME (the French Environmental and Energy Management Agency).

During the Sustainable Development Week 2010, Paris Airports and the ADEME grant "Eco-Friendly Action" certificates to their service providers and partners who take action to limit their environmental impact. The "Eco-Friendly Action" Trophy is awarded to the best initiative for each airport platform.

Base Handling, a subsidiary of SERVAIR, is being honoured for its measure to recover water from ice-cubes. Every day, 600 litres of ice-cubes were thrown into waste compactors and then incinerated, so Base Handling has devised a procedure to limit water consumption by reusing the water from ice-cubes with the help of containers, filters and pumps. 100% of workshop floors are now cleaned with this recycled water.

The solution set up at the Roissy CDG site has been judged exemplary and satisfies the criteria defined by ADP and the ADEME for the "Eco-Friendly Action" Trophies:

- **Sustainability:** recycling the water from ice-cubes represents a volume of 219m³ of water per year, and also reduces the weight of incinerated waste and results in tangible financial savings;
- **Innovation:** the measure developed is innovative with regard to the environment;
- **Reproducibility:** the measure devised by Base Handling can be reproduced at other SERVAIR sites and can also be transposed to other companies;
- **Management:** the established measure is combined with a policy to increase awareness and mobilise staff, thus encouraging an environmental dynamic among the teams.

"SERVAIR is a responsible company, committed to sustainable development. Its efforts have now been rewarded and its employees honoured by the award of the "Eco-Friendly Actions" Trophy. SERVAIR and its subsidiaries also presented four other innovative measures during the Sustainable Development Week and “Eco-Friendly Action” Trophy awards: OAT’s (Orly Air Caterers) obtention of organic certification for its meals; Base Handling and CPA’s reduction of the use of cleaning products; OAT’s implementation of the automatic shutdown of computers; ACNA Orly’s water supply truck.

These measures were all awarded “Eco-Friendly Action” Certificates, in recognition of their promising future and direct contribution to reducing the company’s impact on the environment.
