The Keolis / Servair alliance wins two lots of the European tender of Aéroports de Paris for assistance to passengers with reduced mobility

Servair and Keolis will work through their subsidiaries "Passerelle CDG" at Roissy Terminals 2E, 2F, 2G and 2S and "Prioris" at Orly

Servair, the world's third largest airline air catering and cleaning company, and Keolis, the French leader in urban passenger transport, have won, via a specially and temporary formed joint-venture company (GME), two lots of the European tender of Aéroports de Paris for in-airport assistance to passengers with reduced mobility. Servair and Keolis made a joint submission that met the Aéroports de Paris specifications as a response to an invitation to tender issued in autumn 2007.

The first lot corresponds to the transfer of persons with reduced mobility at Orly and the second, the transfer of passengers at terminals 2E, 2F, 2G and 2S at Roissy. Servair and Keolis will operate the contracts from July 22nd 2008, and for a period of five years, through their dedicated subsidiaries "Passerelle CDG" at Roissy and "Prioris" at Orly.

By combining their expertise in assisting passengers with reduced mobility and their knowledge of airports, Keolis and Servair will offer perfect enhanced process integration, ensuring optimum ease of movement for every traveller with reduced mobility. As per the tender, the range of services will be extended to cover passengers with other types of disabilities (the hard of hearing, those with mental health problems, the partially-sighted, etc.) as well as on a wider geographical area (car parks, hotels, railway stations, etc.).

Beyond their technical expertise, Servair and Keolis share a set of values, which are responsibility, professionalism and respect for passenger. The transport of passengers with reduced mobility requests a fundamental human consideration.
