Flying Food Group and Servair announce the creation of a common company at JFK Airport in New York, strengthening their US partnership.

New York City, June 17, 2009. Flying Food Group (FFG), an international airline and retail catering company founded by Chicago-based entrepreneur Sue Gin in 1983 that operates from thirteen US gateway cities and one in Shanghai, China, and Servair, a subsidiary of Air France founded in 1971 and the top French and the world's 3rd largest airline caterer, are building on their longtime strategic partnership in the US by announcing the creation of a new company named **Flying Food Servair** at New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK). JFK is a primary international gateway city.

Flying Food Servair JFK is a state-of-the-art production unit enjoying close proximity to the terminals. With a surface area of 9847 square meters or 106,000 square feet, it boasts 40,000 meals per day production capacity. Nearly 500 employees will work in this ultra-efficient catering center, which will be managed by Flying Food Servair. The new facility debuts with over 20 longtime FFG international airline customers.
